Stroud Mansion Student Tour Registration

Please read carefully and register for your tour online. Await our confirmation via email.

Payment is made upon arrival at the mansion for your tour.

RESERVATIONS:

Tours may be scheduled Tuesday through Friday between 9:30 a.m. and 1:30 p.m. This is a two-hour tour, so please plan accordingly. Please reserve early enough to allow our staff/volunteers to schedule your desired date.

The Stroud Mansion is a historic 1795 building and only the first floor is wheelchair accessible. Exhibits and items in the collection of the Stroud Mansion are museum-quality; therefore, museum etiquette is required. Students must stay with their group, attended at all times. Unless directed, nothing should be touched, leaned or sat upon. No food, drink or smoking is permitted.

1. Review the tour description, considering application to your grade level(s).
2. Choose desired dates and alternate dates. Changes and/or cancellations should be made as soon as possible. For orientation, plan to arrive 15 minutes before your tour begins.
3. Note maximum numbers of students/chaperones permitted. Your classes may be divided for tours on separate dates. For safety in the mansion, 2 classes or 50 students can be accommodated at one scheduled time. Please ensure that there is a 1:6 supervisor/student ratio for all elementary groups and a 1:10 ratio for older students.
4. Fees are payable, in full, by cash, check or credit card (Mastercard, VISA) upon arrival at the mansion. A receipt for your visit will be given at that time.

Fees: \$5 per student (school/district MCHA member)

\$6 per student (non-member)

No charge for teachers/supervisors *within the ratio limit.*

Beyond the ratio limit, student fee will apply.

5. Parking: There is no parking at the Stroud Mansion. Metered parking is along Main and 9th Sts. Students may be dropped off and picked up at the Main Street entrance to the Stroud Mansion.
6. Cancellations: If your group must cancel a tour, please provide at least 24 hours notice. If the tour was scheduled for a Tuesday, cancellations must be made by the Friday before the scheduled tour by 4 p.m.
